

Certified Training on GRI Standard Transitional Module



According to the Global Reporting Initiative, transitioning from the current Guidelines format to a new set of modular GRI Standards is the next step in the evolution of G4. This move will enable the GRI Standards to be even more widely-referenced by policy initiatives around the world.

Participants will learn about the alignments and differences between G4 and the GRI Standard and develop an understanding of how to implement the GRI Standard into their sustainability reporting.

Who is this training for?

This training is of immense value to all organisations that have taken up Sustainability Reporting, particularly the ones that have either published a GRI report or intend to publish one. Professionals and practitioners advocating Sustainability Reporting as a primary tool for Transparency and Accountability will be particularly benefitted by this training.

What will be covered in this training?

- **GRI Standards introduction:** Identify why GRI Standards were developed, which new features are incorporated, and how it will affect reporters
- **Overview of GRI Standards:** Overview of the new Standards, key content clarifications, employee-worker terminology revision
- **Universal Standards:** Key sections in the Universal Standards, distinction of old concepts and new formats, and other changes
- **Topic-specific Standards:** GRI topic-specific Standards, new formats and new disclosures
- **Key content clarifications:** Key content clarifications between impacts, topic boundary and the link between the two
- **Additional resources:** Additional resources to support reporting and clarify how the transition to the Standards came through
